



**82<sup>nd</sup> Minutes of IASA Board meeting:  
12<sup>th</sup> November 2019, 1 pm (CET)**

1. Approve/revise the 81<sup>st</sup> minutes (5<sup>th</sup> November 2019)
  - The 81<sup>st</sup> minutes are approved without revisions.
2. Updating the websites: we start the discussion about updating the website. We decide:
  - Pat will send the Court Report material to Peter in the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of December.
3. Consideration of bringing new colleagues to Ad Hoc status.
4. DMM News editor is Clark. Bex's title can be Assistant Editor. Bex and Clark will have a meeting soon and will talk about Bex's tasks.

  - Pat suggests thinking about thematic issues. Clark suggests DMM-integrated treatment as a possible theme.
  - Franco tells about one draft of an article for an upcoming issue. He suggests sharing with Clark the link to the folder with the material for DMM News.

6. Scientific meeting:
  - Pat talked with Roehampton about having the next scientific meeting there. Roehampton is prepared to offer the weekends for a scientific meeting with all profit to IASA fellowship. They ask if their students can have a reduction.
  - Pat proposes to ask DMM researchers with publications to give high-level research talks. She mentions Lane, Susan, Andrea, Steve, and Franco. She proposes to pay the travel fees and hotel costs. In the afternoons, there could be workshops held by the IASA-members and other DMMers.
  - After the Roehampton scientific meeting, there could and should be a meeting in Italy, in Bologna. Franco agrees, but we should ask him next year if he is well enough to organize the meeting.
