



**84<sup>rd</sup> Minutes of IASA Board meeting:  
4<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> February 2020**

**IASA meeting by email (first part of 84<sup>th</sup> meeting), 4<sup>th</sup> February 2020**

Present via email on 4<sup>th</sup> February: Pat, Bente, Peter, Shiqin, Clark

1. Approve/revise the 83<sup>rd</sup> minutes (7<sup>th</sup> January 2020)
  - The 83<sup>rd</sup> minutes are approved without revisions.
2. Pat asked the Board to consider the distribution of the fellowship funds and how this can be done.
3. Pat asks Agnes to set up a Zoom meeting link that does not require the originator to be present.

4. Next meeting March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2020, same time as usual.
5. Financial Report:
  - The Financial Report is ready except the owing tax payments.
  - Membership: around 80 persons
  - Together with a regular donation of \$ 500 IASA has a plus of about USD \$3,500 in 2019.
  - Important: To control which members have paid (or not): Becca has the overview.
6. Clark published a forensic overview of the DMM: Applying the Dynamic-Maturational Model of Attachment and Adaptation in criminal justice interventions. Clark will send us a copy of the article (Board and Ad Hoc Board).
7. DMM News:
  - Clark asked two well DMM educated colleagues from Birmingham to help with the DMM News. They will have a look if interesting DMM articles are published.
  - Suggestion that a short abstract of Clark's publication will be published in the next issue of DMM News. Also other DMM publications as they come out.
  - Additionally, Peter had a talk about compulsiveness at the GAIMH Congress in Vienna recently. This is the German Association of Infant Mental Health. On the one hand, a short abstract of his talk could be published in the next issue of DMM News. On the other hand, an article about compulsiveness could be forwarded to GAIMH members. Pat will send an appropriate article to Peter.

8. “Loving and Learning”: In the late seventies, Pat made a book for para-professionals working with young mothers. Pat and Clark are preparing it for a reprint and with the aim to put it on Amazon. There should be a link on the IASA Website to the publication on Amazon. We decide that this is an IASA publication. We all agree to have translations in different languages. Shiqin is ready to begin the Chinese translation as soon as she received the electronic copy.
9. Updated Webpage: Pat asked all trainers facilitate all students of DMM courses to go to the IASA Webpage for developmental and assessment plug-ins. Peter had updated the IASA Webpage.
10. Follow-up on DMM Fellowships: IASA will offer tax-free fellowships. That means that the recipients will have the grant tax-free. Pat suggests that the grant will be paid in portions: every portion for a concrete accomplishment. The Board agrees.
11. Follow-up on the scientific meeting: We have to cancel the scientific meeting in Roehampton. The next scientific meeting will be held in Spring 2021.
